

The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff – Home School Links Project



The aim of the project is to support the emotional wellbeing and literacy achievement of vulnerable pupils in selected primary schools in the Ely area of the City. The project will support and develop home-school links for children at risk of underachieving by working with parents to promote social and emotional well-being and functional literacy skills of pupils. The project will work initially with three primary schools and will roll out to a fourth school in its second and third years.

Teachers at these schools will be seconded to deliver Family Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning (Family SEAL). The project will employ a part-time Project Co-ordinator to support schools in their work with parents and it will be managed by an Educational Psychologist (Senior Practitioner) who will ensure the project links to County initiatives for emotional well-being and literacy.
